

HOW TO CONFIGURE EVENTS LANDING PAGE

At the back-end, go to [Extensions > Extensions Events Manager > Setting](#). Here you will have access to the following configurations:

Edit Events Module:

- ❖ **Limit Events (Calendar):** Limit events on a calendar
- ❖ **Meta Title:** Provide meta title for events landing page
- ❖ **Meta Description:** Provide meta description for events landing page
- ❖ **Meta Keywords:** Provide meta keywords for events landing page
- ❖ **Top Link Name:** Specify name of Events Landing Page link on top bar
- ❖ **Show Map (Venue):** Enable/Disable Map for Venues






